### **Gujarat CM hands over appointment letters to 639 candidates**

GANDHINAGAR: Gujarat Chief Minister Vijay Rupani today handed over the appointment letters for deputy section officer and deputy mamlatdar cadre here in Gandhinagar and called upon for the collective efforts to enhance the confidence of the people for Government Service and Administration.

Rupani motivating the newly appointed candidates said that, as a part of the state's administrative culture, you will now have to fulfil the responsibilities of implementing public decisions that are made by the government, with a human approach. He emphasised on dealing with behaviors and sensitivity that would increase confidence in the system among people.

Deputy Chief Minister Nitin Patel added that the government has been successful in giving more than 80,000 jobs to the youth on the basis of their merit and complete transparency. The recruitment process for government jobs used to be very cumbersome and time consuming in the earlier times.

A total of 639 candidates, which include 445 Deputy Section officers and 194 Deputy Mamlatdars, were handed over their respective letters of appointments by the dignitaries.
